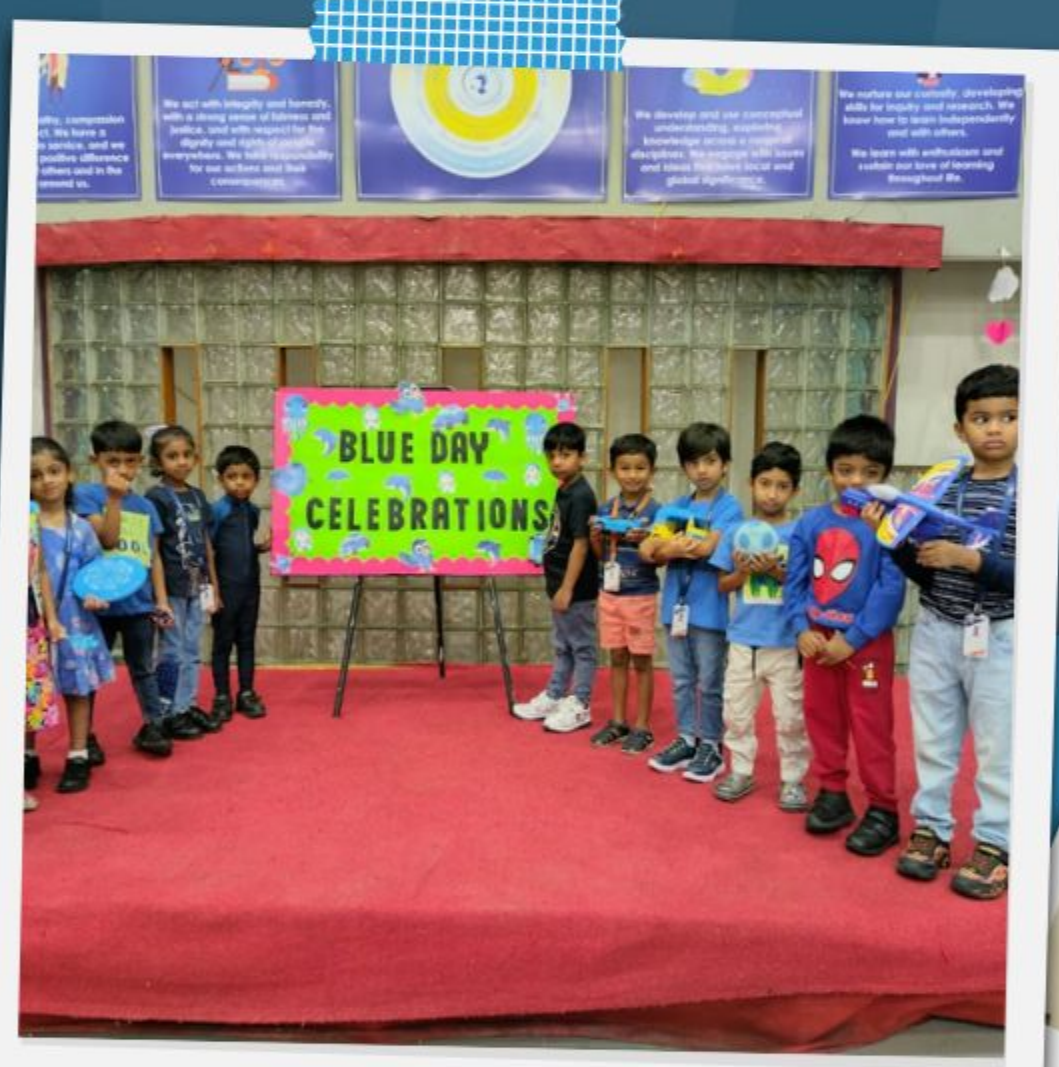






# EYP BLUE DAY

# GARDEN GOODIES

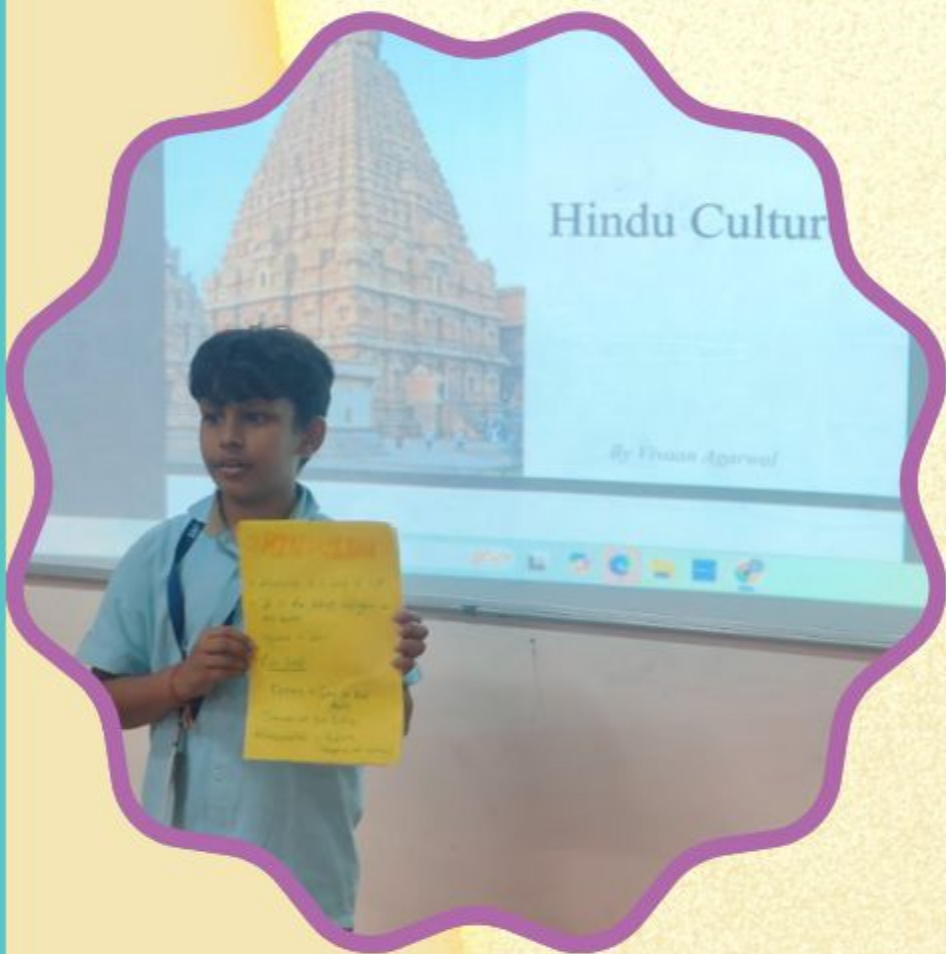

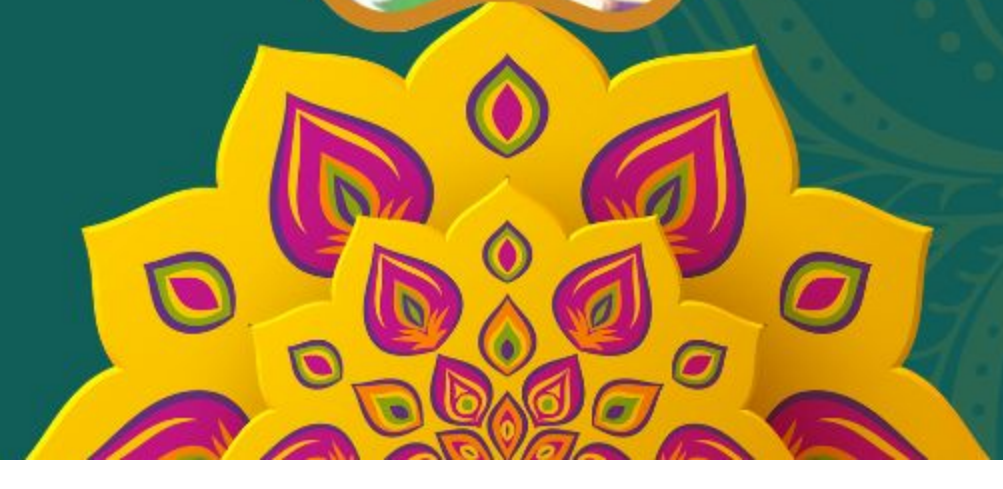




# Happy Diwali

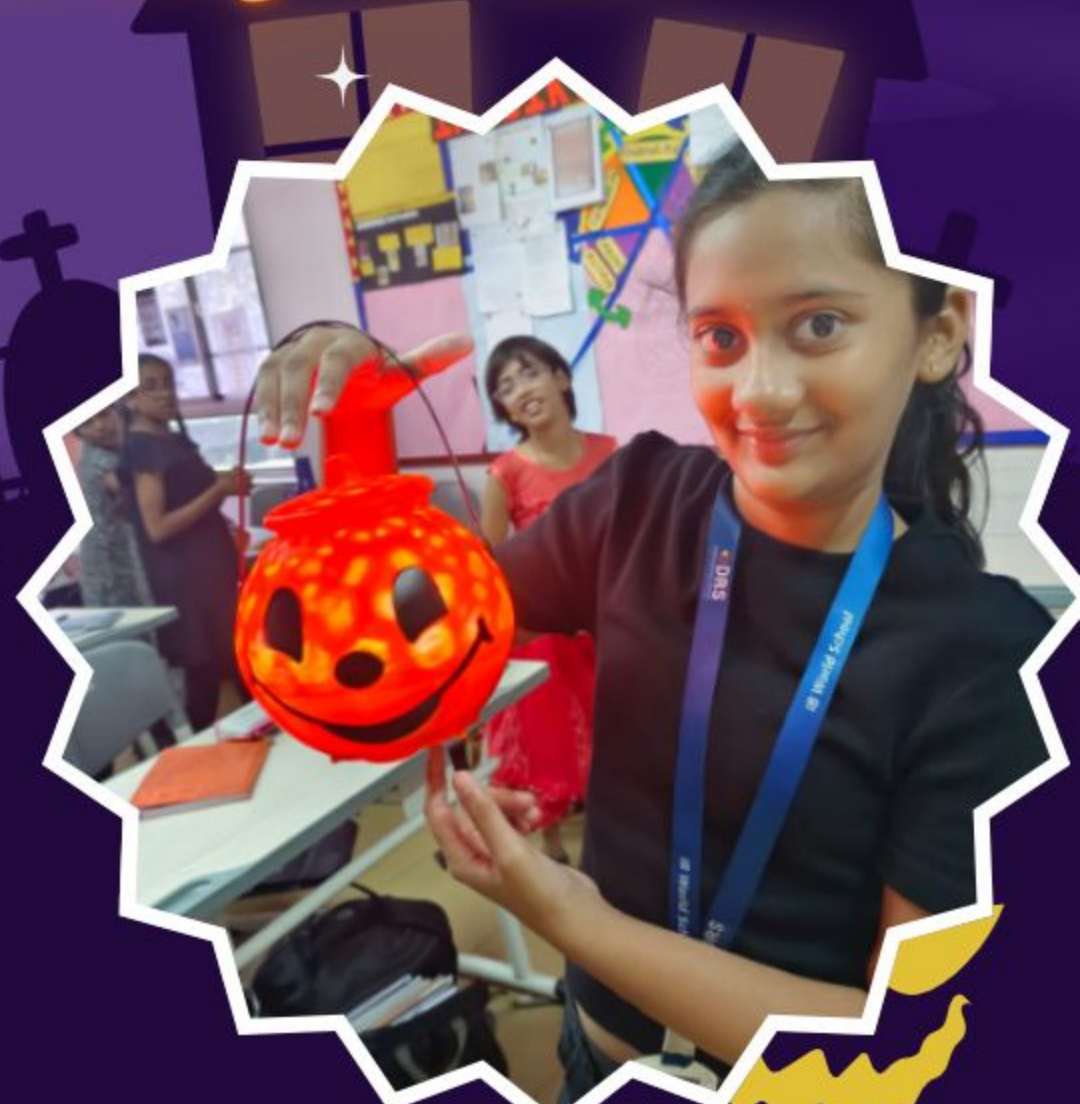




# HAPPY HALLOWEEN!
