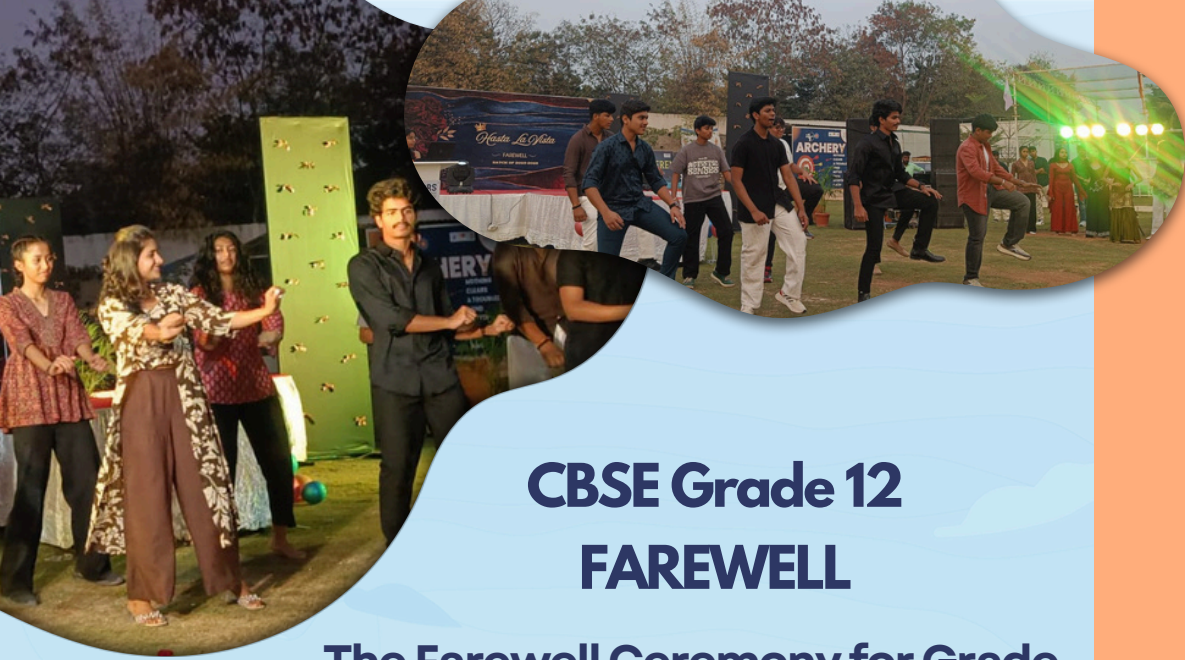


# CBSE Grades 10 & 12 Blessing Ceremony



## RoboCup Junior 2026 National Championship

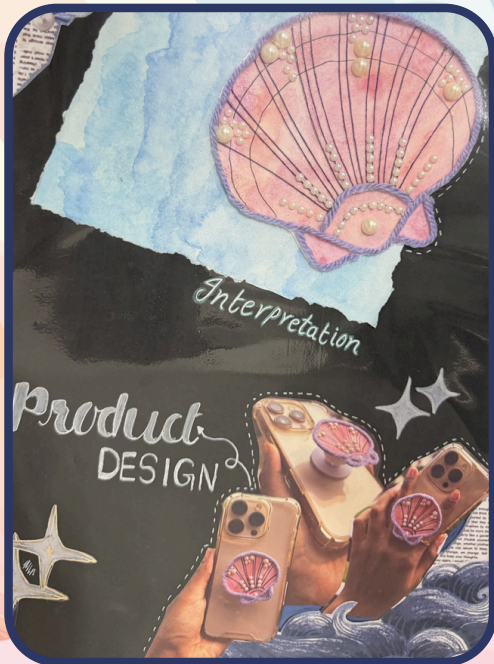
