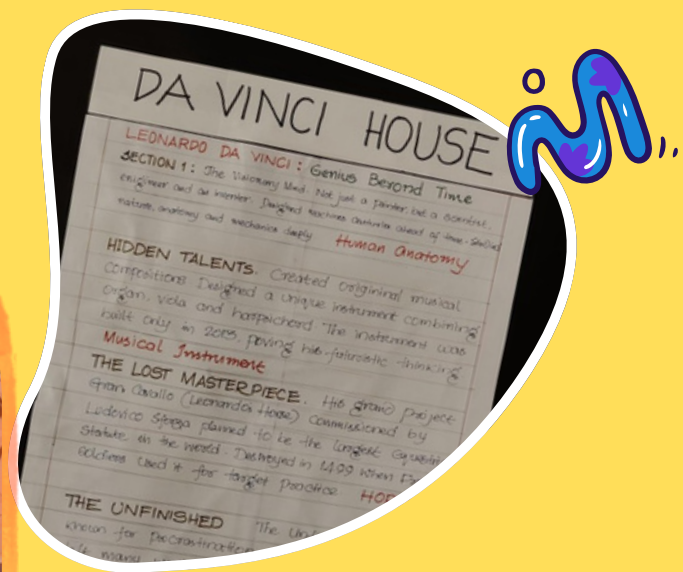
AN EXALTED COMMENCEMENT OF THE ACADEMIC SESSION (2026-27) THROUGH COLLABORATIVE PEDAGOGY

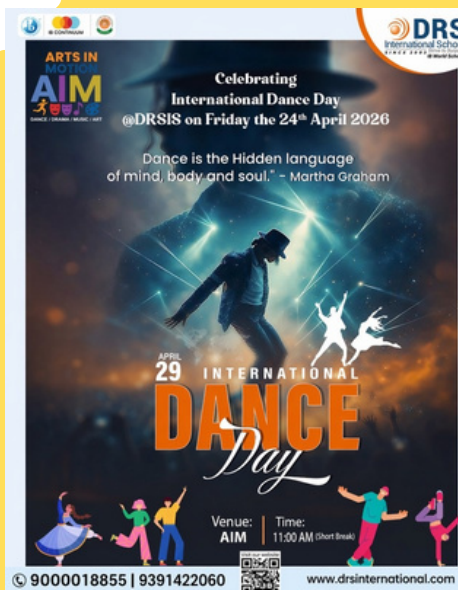

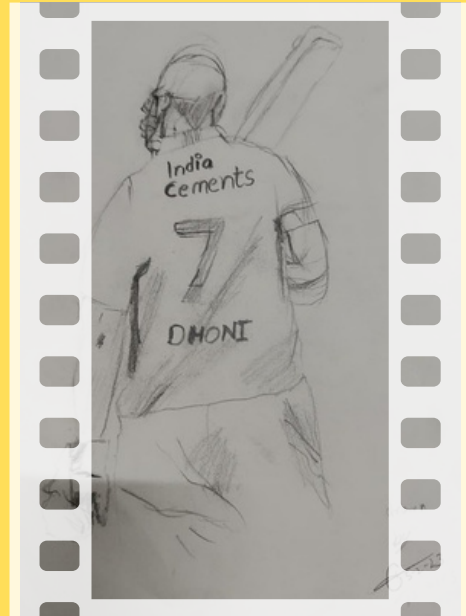
AN EXQUISITE PAGEANTRY OF RHYTHM AND REVERIE
